

SPONSORED READATHON 2ND - 6TH MARCH



Our annual St Luke's Park PTFA sponsored reading challenge starts **Sunday 2nd March.**

Children will receive a star for each book or chapter read/listened to during the challenge. **Both chapters/books they've read themselves and listened to count.** Simply record each chapter/book read/listened to in their reading records and we'll check each day and add their stars. We'll count chapters/books recorded between 2nd-6th March with the final count taking place Friday 7th March.

We have **2 prizes per class** for the most stars - 1 x winner and 1 x runner-up. Winners will receive a £20 Waterstones gift card and runner-ups a £10 Waterstones gift card. There'll also be a special shout out for the class that gets the most stars. We'll share the class totals every day!

This year to make it even easier and for the kids to get involved, we're using **SuperKind** - an award-winning platform for schools and PTFAs. The children can create their own online fundraising page and share to friends and family for sponsorship. Fundraisers are directly connected to our PTFA pot. At the end of the challenge, every child that's raised funds will get a certificate.

To set up their pages, it's **super simple and free.** All you need to do is visit <https://superkind.org/campaign/st-lukes-park-ptfa-st-lukes-park-primary-sponsored-readathon> and click **join the campaign.** Set up your account, the kids can write their own intro and set their own fundraising target. Top tip, if you're adding photos - consider adding a password so that when you share your link to your child's page, only those that you have shared the link and password can then view these.

Last year with less than 100 kids we raised over £800, so this year we're setting a target of **£1,000!** Please set up your child's page today and spread the word! All money raised is spent on activities and material that develop a love of reading.
